


LIGHT AMPLIFICATION

Light amplification happens when the sun reflects off of certain surfaces, and is directed into one area on the Oceangrip material and is not something that is covered under our standard warranty. The Oceangrip will last longer if it is not exposed to the elements when not in use. Storing indoors or under a cover/boat slip is the best option to avoid light amplification burns. Avoid placing the material near reflective surfaces as these objects can refract/reflect light and can be destructive to the material.





Oceangrip Inc. Limited Warranty

I. Acknowledgement to the Buyer

By purchasing Oceangrip material the buyer accepts the warranty and agrees to the following:

1. The buyer has reviewed, understands, and agrees to the following terms and limitations of the warranty.
2. The buyer has received the opportunity to consult with Oceangrip regarding the warranty and the limitations. The buyer has not relied upon any statements or representations of Oceangrip for buyer's understanding or interpretation of any provision hereof.

II. Warranty Coverage

1. The warranty covers that the products are free from defects in workmanship and materials at the time of manufacture and for a period of twelve (12) consecutive months from the date of shipment.
2. The warranty provided is subject to the strict precondition provided that the covered products are used and maintained in accordance with all Oceangrip preparation, installation, and storage.
3. Improper installation and/or repair voids the warranty in its entirety, without exception.

III. Not covered under warranty

1. The warranty does not cover the installation of the product onto any surface, nor does it cover adhesion of the product to the boat or to any other surface to which the covered products are applied.
2. The warranty applies only to the material and workmanship of the products itself.
3. Some fading and/ or discoloration of the material may occur with time and use in the marine environment; such fading and/or discoloration is not covered by warranty.
4. The warranty only covers excessive fading or polymer degradation resulting from defective material. The warranty specifically EXCLUDES deformation, discoloration or other damage to the covered product. In addition, the warranty EXCLUDES all other damage or loss, resulting from the covered product being subjected to temperatures in excess to 165 degree Fahrenheit. (See lamp amplification attached)
5. Oceangrip shall not be responsible for any damage or loss resulting from any application or use of the covered product which exceeds the max temperature. Installations resulting in the covered product's experiencing temperatures in excess of the max temperature will void this warranty and its entirety.

IV. Oceangrip procedures:

1. Products determined by Oceangrip to have material and/ or workmanship defects will be covered as follows:
 - A. Products deemed by Oceangrip to be defective within twelve (12) months of shipment will be replaced or a refund for the defective product will be provided.
 - B. At Oceangrip's sole option, they may choose to cover the shipping charges of the replacement pad for shipping within the United States. The buyer will be responsible for all shipping charges for international shipping.
2. Procedure:
 - A. The buyers shall first submit photographs depicting the defective condition.
 - B. The buyer shall then return the product for inspection
 - C. If deemed defective by Oceangrip, the material will be replaced or a refund will be issued for products in accordance with the terms stated herein.

V. Limitations on Oceangrip liability and miscellaneous provisions:



1. Oceangrips total liability under this warranty shall not exceed the replacement value of the covered product.
2. In no event will OceanGrip be liable under any theory of liability or be obligated for consequential or indirect damages of any type or nature.
3. This warranty shall not be assigned or transferred by the buyer without prior written approval from OceanGrip.
4. The warranty shall be governed by and constructed according to the laws of the state of Florida, U.S.A. The parties agree to personal jurisdiction in the state of Florida.

IV. Warranty Disclaimers:

1. This warranty supersedes and replaces any previous warranty made or offered to the buyer by OceanGrip, including but not limited to any warranty set forth in any other agreement between the parties hereto.
2. OceanGrip specifically disclaims all warranties of any kind, express or implied, not specifically set forth in this warranty. Other than as specifically set forth in this warranty; (1) there are no warranties established or implied, (2) There are no warranties which extend beyond the description on the face hereof, (3) no express warranty is given; and (4) No affirmation of fact or promise made by OceanGrip, by word or action, shall constitute a warranty.
3. All implied warranties of merchantability and/or fitness or suitability for a particular purpose are expressly excluded from this warranty.
4. Except for the provisions set forth in this warranty, no agent, employee, subcontractor, or representative of OceanGrip has any authority to bind any other affirmation, representations, or warranty concerning the product sold to the buyer. Unless an affirmation, representation or warranty is specifically included in this warranty, it shall not be enforceable by the buyer.
5. OceanGrip may, from time to time, in their sole discretion offer to repair or replace covered product in certain specific situations. Such offers by OceanGrip, Inc, if made, are not to be construed as a waiver of any exclusion or other limitation to this warranty stated herein, nor are they to be construed as a course of dealing that in any way modified the terms of this warranty.
